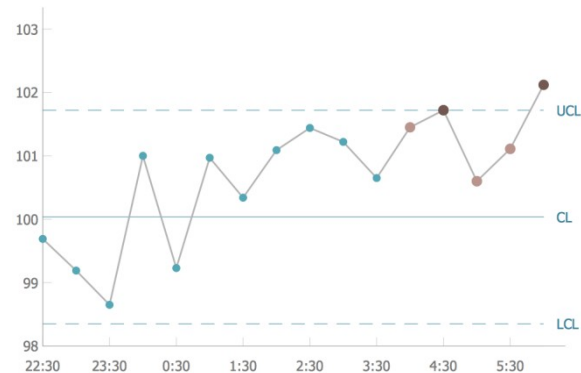


Quality Training for Physicians
